- DG CRMS (NADRA) designated as member of the Committee on 21 Jul 2014 by Planning Commission of Pakistan

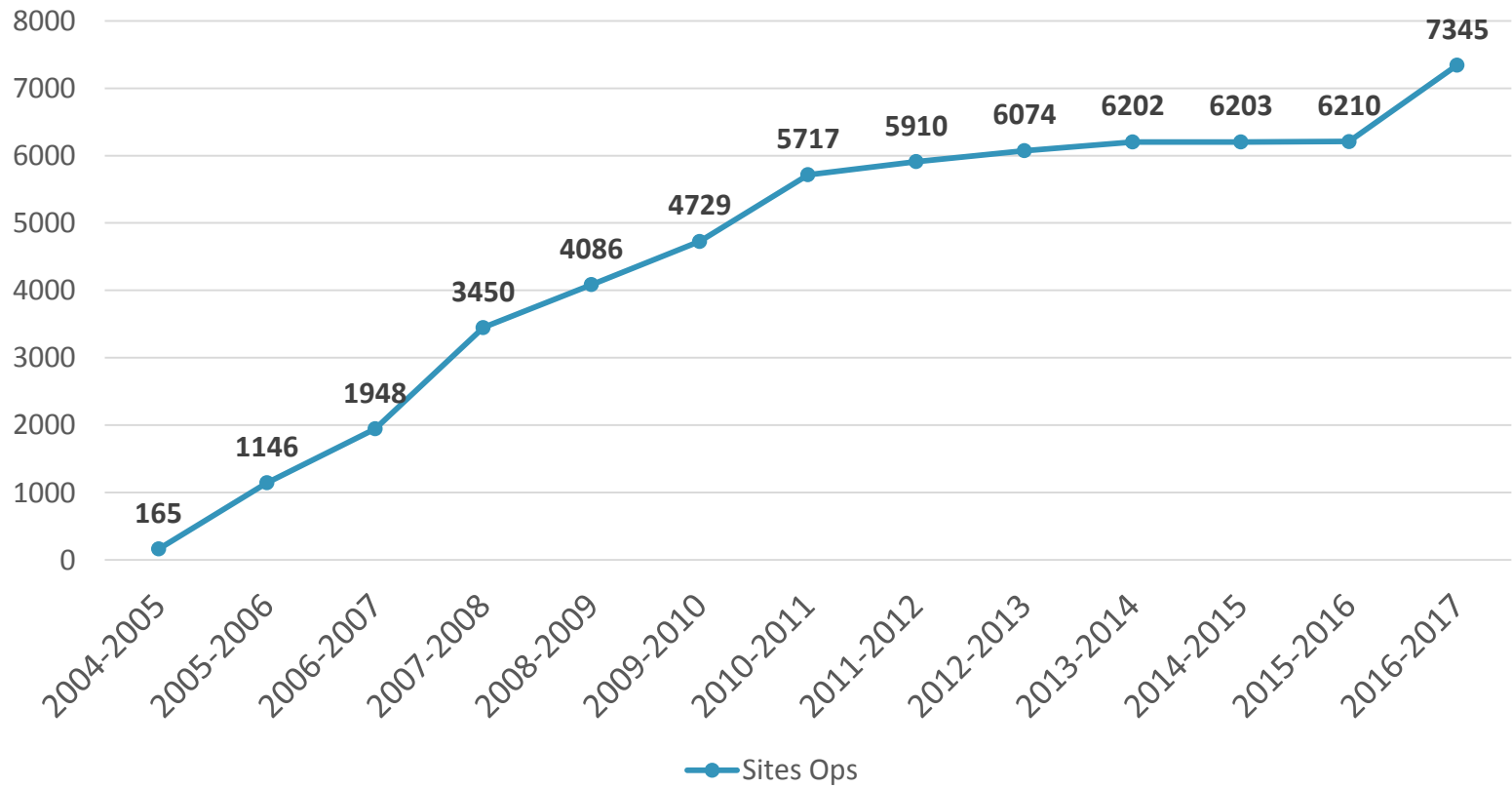
NADRA INITIATIVES TO IMPROVE CRVS

- Launching of new design of digitally secured paper for CRMS certificates
- Introduction of verification mechanism to check authenticity of new digitally secured paper
- Development of online application with a view to acquiring authenticated information aimed at real-time flow of civil registration data
- Expansion of CRMS operations to ensure availability of registration facilities, across the country
- 4476x new CRMS Sites (UCs ,MCs, Village Councils, Neighborhood Councils) created 2016-17

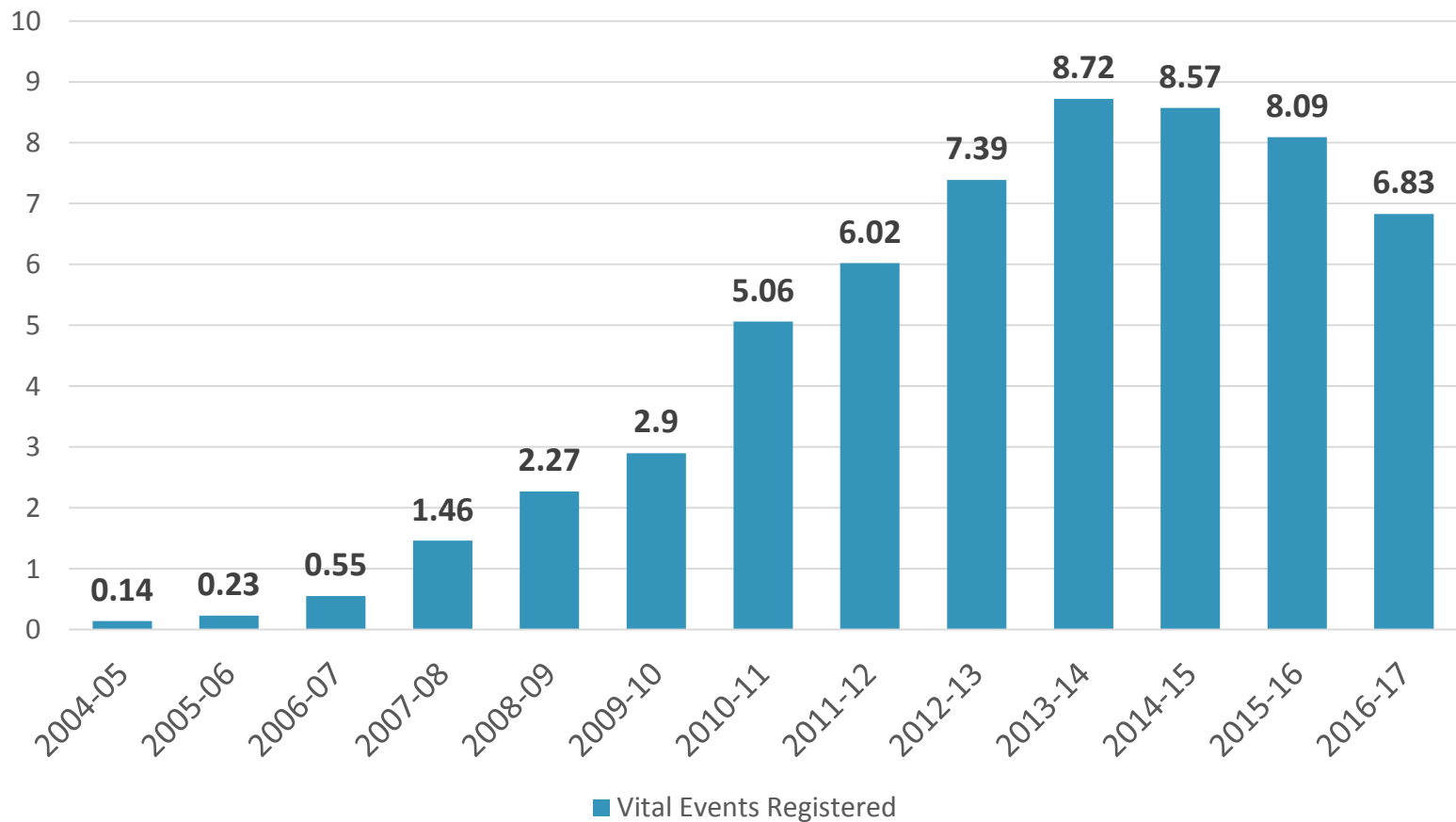

RECOMMENDATIONS TO INCREASE REGISTRATION

- **Regulatory Authority:** To be Formulated at Federal level to create a link between Civil Registration and Local Govts
- **Capacity Development:** Civil Registration Infrastructure be strengthened at grass root level through provision of equipment, HR and regular training
- **Upgrading:** Existing IT equipment at UC level
- **Linking of Health and Education Facilities:** Linking with Civil Registration System be created

RECOMMENDATIONS TO INCREASE REGISTRATION

- **Awareness Campaign:** Be launched for General public to enhance registration
- **Legal System:** Be created for ensuring reporting of events on occurrence
- **Registration Centers:** Hubs be established for general public registration
- **Incentives:** For staff involved in civil registration process
