- To develop high level human resources who would contribute to appropriate policy decision and its implementation for tackling political and developmental issues in respective fields.
- To establish and maintain mid and long term good relations between the target countries and Japan.

Eligibility criteria:-

The applicant should:

- Be a young or middle government officer, prospective academics, personal from private institutions who are expected to contribute policy formulation or its implementation for tackling sustainable developmental issues in respective fields.
- Be under the age of 40 years, in principal (as of April 1st, 2019).
- Have a Bachelor degree or Master degree
- Have a sufficient command of English in speaking and writing
- Be in good health both physically and mentally to participate in the program in Japan
- Not be serving any form of military service.
