Eligibility Criteria

- Be Government Officers (BS-17 and above) only and nominated by respective Federal Government or Provincial Department having a minimum 2 years of experience in related field
- Have a Bachelor's degree or higher concerned with Public Management and Public Sector Reforms.
- Have a good command of both spoken and written to take classes conducted entirely in English and to be able to write academic reports and theses in English
- Be under 40 years of age as of February 1, 2018 and in good health, both physically and mentally to complete the program.
- Having Tuberculosis or any kind of contagious disease is regarded as a disqualifying condition for participating in this program
- Not be a person who has withdrawn before from KOICA,s scholarship program
- Person belonging to the institution in which candidates submitted false documents and returned to his/her country arbitrarily in the middle of SP program cannot be applied
- Have not participated in KOICA,s scholarship program or any of the Korean Government's Scholarship program previously (Master's degree program)

Objectives


- To improve the analytical and managerial skills of mid-level public official in developing countries by knowledge about personnel management, public organization, public finances, local government and policy process.
