Mandatory	a. Permanent Government Officers (BS-17 and above) only and nominated by respective Department b. Be in a position of director or representative of teacher education and training departments at the Ministry of education or central institutes affiliated with governments of the participating countries c. Has not participated in the same or similar KOICA fellowship program in past 3 years unless otherwise specified; d. Sufficient proficiency in written and spoken English to actively participate in seminars and write an Action plan; e. Be in good health both physically and mentally, to undergo the course;
Preferable	a. Have a Working knowledge in regard to teacher education and training; b. Have rich experience in national education policy development, official Development Assistance (ODA) projects or International education co-operation.

- To share the best practices and current issues in regard to teacher education and training system from participating countries and the Republic of Korea
- To cultivate policy development capacities for quality teacher education and training system.
- To strengthen future cooperation in the areas of teacher education and training among participating countries, including the Republic of Korea.
- To contribute to capacity development of individual participants as well as the participants' organizations and countries.
