- Currently working with experience in environmental control and management. Candidates from government/private sector are preferable.
- Graduate with university degree in science or engineering.
- Good command of spoken and written English
- In good health both physically and mentally.

Objectives


This training course aims at raising awareness of clean technology and low industrial waste to promote eco-industry. At the end of this course, participants are expected to:

- Understand clean technology with the benefits of releasing low industrial waste under the context of Eco-industry.
- Understand process of recycling industrial waste.
- Understand significance of BAT/BEP concept under the context of UNIDO and be able to apply this knowledge to industrial sector of his/her own country.
- Gain awareness on the toxicity of dioxins and polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons.
- Be able to interpret toxic chemicals released from each type of fuels including their heat efficiencies.
- Be able to provide the knowledge of specialty associated with industrial boilers coupled with its heat efficiencies.
- Understand the public participation as one of the social tools to raise public awareness between industrial sector and local community.
