2. **Objectives:**

- To provide a forum for all participants to share views and exchange ideas on micro credit and sufficiency economy development, community empowerment and poverty reduction.
- To encourage the participants to understand the concepts of micro credit sufficiency economy, community and economy development, community empowerment and poverty reduction
- To understand the philosophy and concept of micro credit and sufficiency economy development
- To apply the knowledge and experiences gained to use in their own countries

Eligibility Criteria:


- Have more than 5 years of occupational experience in relevant fields
- Competency in both speaking and written English.
- Must be in good health, both physically and mentally, to participate in the project. As the project includes field trips, that may give risk to pregnant body, pregnancy is regarded as a disqualifying condition for participation in this project
- Age should be between the ages of thirty (30) and fifty (50) years.

3. The Colombo Plan will provide economy class round trip air ticket for the participants and TICA will provide the training program, accommodation, daily allowance and life and health insurance. Any additional costs such as visa fees etc. are to be borne by the participants or by their nominating government.
